



Please do not drain garbage onto the sink. Politely requested to put it into Fumotoppara garbage bag, bring it to the garbage station and throw away there.



If you would like to wash your bonfire stand or stove, please use the garbage station's water tap.

We strongly ask you to use Fumotoppara garbage bag (costs 100 JPY), when you throw away usual garbage at Fumotoppara garbage station.

Garbage classification

combustible garbage, food waste, vinyl

Fumotoppara garbage bag

can. bottle. PET bottle. GAS can, cardboard, into the fitting stvrofoam. plastic belt

without garbage bag, just put garbage container

ash

extinguish the ash and pour into the drum can (no garbage bag needed)

incombustible garbage, grill, peg, battery etc.


No open flames

To enjoy safe camping, please respect the following rules



Speed limit inside the camp

Don't drive faster than 10km/h. Please take care of walkers and gutters. We encourage you to walk as much as possible inside of the campsite instead of using your car.

No car moving after 5 p.m.

When it becomes dark, driving inside the campsite is very dangerous. Re-entering is possible until 5 p.m.

If re-entering exceeds this time, additional fee will be charged. If delay is too late, re-entring could be refused.

Possible to leave the campsite early in the morning, just we kindly ask you to be as silent as possible, not to disturb other guests in their peace.



Please help us to protect old trees

At our campsite you can find beautiful old oak trees. We kindly ask you not to pitch a tent or hammock close to those trees and also avoid parking there.



Please be quiet at the campsite After 5 p.m. no music is allowed

At night Fumotoppara is very peaceful. We kindly request you to be as silent as possible, not to disturb other campers in their rest.

Din, loud talking and the act of making disturbing noise is prohibited

- Listening music or movie so loudly that your neighbour camper can hear
- Car's idling, unnecessary door closing-opening
- Loud speaking
- Party

Example for dim

Chopping wood early at the morning or late at night

Please restrain yourself from loud music also at daytime.

Be silent after 8 p.m.

Please keep in mind, at night normal voices and sounds travel better.

Caution drinking alcohol

that is suitable for the circumstances.

Fumotoppara is 830m high from sea level, so it is easier to get drunk. Unreasonable drinking will drive you into dim, cause trouble with campers around you. Respectfully request to drink in a manner,

proven, we will warn you. After warning we could not realise any improvement in your behaviour, we will ask you to leave our campsite immediately.

When your disturbing behaviour is

Generator and idling are forbidden



Fire warning In case of accidental fire, the responsibility lies with who caused the fire.

- No open flames allowed Always use a fire pit or stove
- ■In case of strong wind (more than 4m/s) no bonfires allowed Could cause fire or disturb other campers. Please check the wind speed at the live camera on our homepage.
- Keep your eyes on the fire
- Before sleeping, extinguish the fire properly
- Please do not throw away the used ash at the camp field Extinguish properly the ash and pour into the drum can.
- Firework is forbidden In case of small fireworks (hand size), set off is possible between 6 p.m. - 8 p.m. at the parking area front of the Administration building.



Using charcoal fire or gas fire inside of the tent risking carbon monoxide poisoning, for this reason we strongly ask you not use fire/flame inside of the tent or car. Using a stove, please be careful with the ventilation and before sleeping extinguish properly.

「Call out」「Look into」 behaviour is forbidden

Please refrain [call out] or [look into] behaviour in order to content making for social sites. Please respect others' privacy.



Wild animal countermeasure

Fumoto (around Fumotoppara) is wild animal habitat area.

- Please do not leave food or garbage at the field site.
- Out of the opening hours of Garbage station (8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m.) throw away is not possible.



Be cautious using machete or axe

During firewood chopping your hand could be injured heavily. For this reason, we recommend using a fixer etc. take measures to prevent the blade from hitting your hand. Fumotoppara is far from any medical institution, to go there or to wait for an ambulance both take time.
