## Speed limit inside the camp

Don't drive faster than 10km/h. Please take care of walkers and gutters.

We encourage you to walk as much as possible inside of the campsite instead of using your car.

## Please be guiet at the campsite

At night Fumotoppara is very peaceful. We kindly request you to be as silent as possible, not to disturb other campers in their rest.

#### Din, loud talking and the act of making disturbing noise is prohibited

- Car's idling, unnecessary door closing-opening
- Example for dim Loud speaking

  - Chopping wood early at the morning or late at night

Fire warning In case of accidental fire, the responsibility lies with who caused the fire.

#### No open flames allowed

Always use a fire pit or stove

In case of strong wind (more than 4m/s) no bonfires allowed Could cause fire or disturb other campers

Please check the wind speed at the live camera on our homepage

- Keep your eyes on the fire. Before sleeping, extinguish the fire properly
- Please do not throw away the used ash at the camp field

Extinguish properly the ash and pour into the drum can.

Firework is forbidden

In case of small fireworks (hand size), set off is possible between 6 p.m. - 8 p.m. at the parking area front of the Administration building.

Using charcoal fire or gas fire inside of the tent risking carbon monoxide poisoning, for this reason we strongly ask you not use fire/flame inside of the tent or car. Using a stove, please be careful with the ventilation and before sleeping extinguish properly.

#### Wild animal countermeasure

Fumoto (around Fumotoppara) is wild animal habitat area. Please do not leave food or garbage at the fild site. Out of the opening hours of Garbage station (8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m.) throw away is not possible.


